TONNEAU COVER FITTING INSTRUCTION

Ford Ranger XLT Dual Cab With Factory Sport Bar 2007 – October 2011

1. TONNEAU COVER FITTING

NOTE: Read entire instructions prior to start.

1.1 BASIC TOOL REQUIRED

Drill, 4mm Drill Bit, Tape Measure, Rivet Gun, Marking Pencil / Pen, Clear Silicone / Silicone Gun

1.2 CONTENTS

1 x Tonneau Cover 2 x Bar Brackets

1 x Tonneau Support Bar 30 x Rivets


3 x Aluminium Ropetrack (484mm) 18 x Rope Buttons

1x Fitting Instruction - 4 x Dowels

1.3 TONNEAU COVER INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Using two pieces of dowel, join the 3 aluminum rope tracks together.
- 2. Place the aluminum rope track centralised on the top of the front of the tub with the opening facing the cab, position the rope track 22mm forward of the base of the Sports Bar.
- 3. Using a 4 mm drill bit, drill 6 evenly spaced holes through the aluminum rope track into the tub.
- 4. Once all the holes have been drilled, remove the dowelling pieces. Squeeze silicon sealant along the back of the rope tracks and pop rivet into place.
- 5. Slide the front of the tonneau cover through the aluminium rope track section
- 6. To fit the bar brackets, measure 765mm back from the inside front edge at the top of the tub and place them as shown in Figure 2. (5mm down from top edge of tub) Drill and rivet using two large rivets for each Bar Bracket. Install the support bar according to the supplied instructions.
- 7. To fit the round buttons (body hooks) to the tub, drape tonneau cover support bar & tub, using the seam on both the tailgate and the side panels as a line of reference.

- 8. Tailgate: Using the lower edge of the seam as the reference line; line up each hook individually to each bunji (loop) and drill and rivet the round buttons in line 395mm up from the bottom edge of the Tailgate.
- 9. Side panels: Line up each hook individually to each bunji (loop), alternating from side to side. The first bunji at the side rear of car is 120mm down from the top **inside** edge in line with the rear tie-down bolt. Drill and rivet round body hooks, alternating from side to side. The remaining buttons are 140mm down from the top **inside** edge.



2. CARING FOR YOUR TONNEAU

Apply bee's wax or Dri-lube to stitching a few times a year, as this will maintain the tonneau's waterproofing ability and prevent the stitching from degrading. Use a mild detergent and soft scrubbing brush to clean tonneau.

Never drive without tonneau support bars in place as flapping can cause a delaminating effect on the material.

3. MULTI-FIT SUPPORT BAR

The Aussie Tonneau Multi - Fit Support Bar is designed to fit almost all Utes on the Market, from Suburu Brumbys to Cab Chassis aluminium trays.

3.1 BASIC TOOL REQUIRED

- Drill, 4mm drill bit

3.2 MULTI-FIT SUPPORT BAR CONTENTS

- 1 x hollow bar centrepiece
- 2 x grub screws
- 2 x solid bar end piece

3.3 FITTING MULTI-FIT SUPPORT BAR

- 1. Insert solid bar pieces into either end of hollow tube. Adjust bar so it fits between bar bracket holders with the holes facing to the ground (so the grub screws don't rub against the tonneau), as shown above and then with a white pencil make a mark through the small holes of the hollow bar onto the solid ends. This is where you will drill a hole to the depth of about 1-2mm (do not go any further)
- 2. Join the pieces back together and screw grub screws through the hollow bar into the holes that you drilled. **Make sure you do not over tighten the grub screws**. Refit the bar. You may kink the bar in the middle to give it some extra height to assist with water runoff.
